PENSIONS ASSISTANCE

We have an experienced Pensions Advocate trained under the current legislation to assist you in your enquiries. This Advocate will be able to give information on entitlements to Health Care and services, Pensions, particularly disability pensions and other available benefits. Also they can assist in relevant documentation, application forms etc. Keeping the Veteran informed on the progress and any outcomes is normal procedure.

All claims are dealt with in a timely and courteous manner with privacy paramount.

Are your records up to date?

These services are provided to Veterans and their spouses, partners and dependents living in Moe and the surrounding areas.

It is a one-stop service staffed by volunteers supported by the Department of Veterans Affairs and various Ex-service organisations, which provide information about entitlements to Pensions, give assistance in making claims and offer advice on Welfare matters.

Our staff have a wide range of skills enabling them to assist Veterans and their dependents in dealings with the Department of Veterans Affairs. They also work with organizations in the wider Community and the local Councils and regions.


